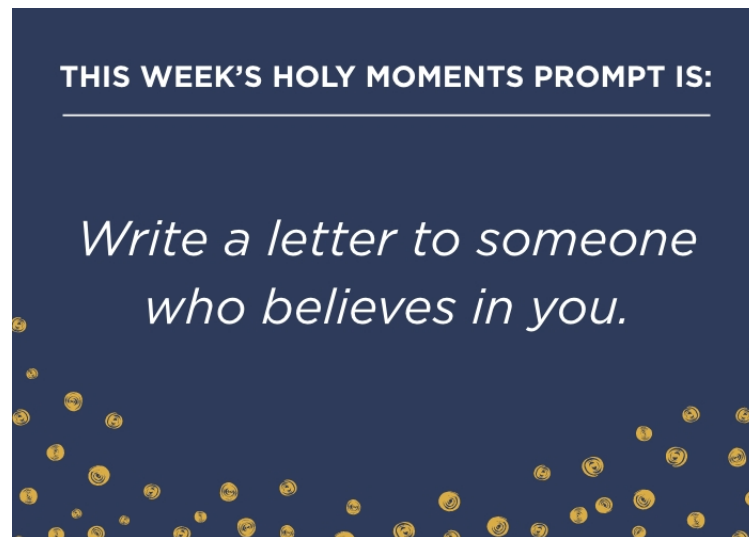
This week we saw some incredible Holy Moments!
