Inclement Weather

Saints Peter & Paul School will follow ROCORI for all weather-related school delays, early outs, or closings. You will be notified through text and email from Gradelink if there is a change in our school schedule.

The first snow day is a FREE day (not a Flexible Learning Day). After that, teachers will communicate their flexible learning plans with you. You have 3 days to turn in the work.

If the work is not turned in it will be marked as an unexcused absence.

Late start: No morning Pre-K class. Before School Age Care will be available only for students who regularly attend beginning at 6:30 AM.

No School: School Age Care is closed.

Early out: No School Age Care.

Flexible Learning days (FLD)

Flexible Learning Days (FLD) are in place for SNOW DAYS ONLY. The first snow day is FREE no homework.

What is a Flexible Learning Day?

Flexible Learning Day (FLD) refers to a school day when students, instead of coming to school, stay safely at home and communicate with teachers via email, phone, or other online resources or continue their learning through prearranged learning assignments. On Flexible Learning Days, teachers will hold office hours in which they are available to provide learning support to students.

Assignments & Attendance:

The assignments will be proof of attendance on Flexible Learning Days. Attendance will be taken 3 days after the flexible learning day. Assignments must be turned in 3 days after the Flexible Learning Day or sooner. Students are counted present once assignments are turned in. Students who do not turn in their assignments will be marked as unexcused absent.

Please refer to your child's classroom teacher for assignment directions for completion and for turning it in.

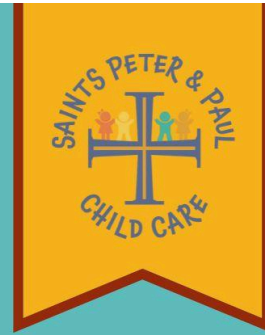
